Room 14 Update

In Visual Art we have been learning about the elements of art. We drew inspiration from Pete Cromer's work which uses a variety of bright colours and shapes to represent animals. We created our own artwork on native plants that we noticed around the school or are known to us. We used lots of bright colours and layered different shapes to recreate our native species.

In keeping with our theme of nature and colour we learnt about warm and cool colours. We recreated trees in autumn with warm colours and cool colours.

We continue to use the Orton-Gillingham approach in our spelling lessons and have been practising our syllable division. We have learnt about a variety of syllable types and are now applying them to longer words. We have been building our morphology knowledge and recognise how knowing the meaning of affixes and roots can help us to understand new words.

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

Report on Casual Day Fundraiser for Gogo Orphanage in Malawi Africa.

Last term our school raised \$439.55 for play equipment for Gogo. We organized for 2 soccer goals and 2 netball goals to be welded by local tradesmen. The nets were hand made by locals as this type of equipment is not commercially available in Malawi.
