Reception Enrolments 2024

We are currently receiving an increasing number of enrolments for the start of 2024 and the Mid-Year intake in Term 3, 2024. If you are planning to enrol a reception student next year in either intake, please fill out your intention to enrol on our website, or preferably collect an enrolment pack from the Front Office, fill out the enrolment form and return to the

Front Office ASAP. Please inform any families that are not currently on our distibution list about our enrolment procedures, especially children that will begin at the start of 2024.

We organising reception enrolment interviews mid-way through Term 3 for those commencing at the start of 2024, and interviews will commence in Term 1 2024 for those starting mid-year. Transition days will begin in Term 4 for those commencing at the start of 2024, and transition days will occur in Term 2 for the Mid-Year intake.

If any families need assistance with determining which intake a reception child should be enrolled in, please contact the front office. We have a 2024 enrolment calculator that will assist with this. If you have any other queries, please contact the school and we can try to assist in any way we can.



National NAIDOC Week
