Room 1 Update

Throughout this term, Room One has been exploring the important Math concept of Position and Placement. We read the book 'Rosie's Walk'

to establish a baseline understanding of positional language such as under, over, around and through. We all had a wonderful time making a story map to track Rosie's Walk. We even made our own Rosie out of plasticine to follow our labelled story map.

Our understanding of positional language was also incorporated into our Child Protection Curriculum topic of Safety. To finish our Math topic this term we played a game where we had to move around the room safely and then position ourselves safely under, behind, in-between or on top of items in our classroom.




As part of our NAIDOC Week Activities, Wendy Nicolle and our shared Eco Leaders their knowledge of bush tucker, art story telling and country with every class in the school. The students were able to feel and bush tucker such as taste Warrigal Greens and Salt Bush which are grown in our


Reconciliation Garden. They also learned about traditional Indigenous symbols and their meaning.
