Phonics Screen Check

Last week our year 1 teachers conducted the Phonics Screen Check which is a statewide assessment to ensure students are tracking well with their phonics knowledge. We are thrilled with the results that 84% of our year 1 students exceeded the pass rate which is a significant improvement on previous years (76% in 2022 and 61% in 2021). Most students were very close to the benchmark and are already receiving intervention. This is a positive indication of the hard work we have put into improving our Literacy across the school. 

Pupil Free Day

On Friday 1st September staff focused on preparing for their reading fluency daily lessons.

"Reading fluency makes comprehension possible and motivates students to read. When our students develop the fluency skills to read with reasonable accuracy, at an appropriate rate, with good expression – making what they read sound like speech - deep understanding and enjoyment of reading can happen." - Drs Hasbrouck and Glaser, Reading Fluency: Understand – Assess – Teach

Fluency is the ability to read text accurately, quickly and with expression. It occurs without conscious effort when all the component skills of reading are in place so the reader can focus on the meaning of a text. Fluent readers can maintain their skill over very long periods of time and can generalise across texts.



Staff also set about preparing for our 2 new classrooms which will be located in our Junior Primary building. We will be ordering new furniture and replacing the older style smartboards with new interactive screens ready for 2024.

New Flag Poles and Garden Upgrade

We have 3 new flag poles on the northeastern corner near the carpark entrance. They will replace the old weathered one at the main entrance to the school. It will be an eye-catching addition to Happy Valley Primary School especially when driving along Education Road.
