The Happy Valley Primary School Uniform consists of the following acceptable items which can be purchased from the school uniform shop or on Qkr!

**Shoes:** black leather school shoes, sneakers in mostly black or white, or closed toe and heel sandals. Any laces need to be black or white, to match the shoe  
During kitchen lessons students need to wear enclosed shoes

**Socks:** plain black or white

## **Uniform**

The school uniform has been endorsed by the Governing Council and is smart, comfortable and based on the school colours of green and gold.

All children are required to wear the recommended school uniform unless exempted. A school uniform gives children a sense of belonging, develops pride in the school and discourages clothing fashion competition amongst students.

## **Further Information**

Hats are compulsory for students in Terms 1 and 4. For safety reasons we promote a no hat, no play policy. Therefore students without hats in terms 1 and 4 will need to remain in designed shaded areas.

We recommend that students with long hair keep this tied back. This is especially important during sports lessons and if students have cooking lessons in our kitchen.

A few times a year the school has a casual day. We do ask that any clothing worn on casual days is appropriate for school, is not revealing and is SunSmart. Parents shall be contacted by leadership if students have failed to wear the correct uniform or not dress appropriately.

## **Monitoring**

Classroom teachers and leadership will monitor that students are dressing correctly. Students who do not comply will have a note placed in their diary to be signed by the parent/caregiver.

If a student continues to fail to wear their school uniform after notes have been sent home a meeting will be made with them and leadership to resolve any religious, medical or financial issue preventing the student from wearing their uniform.

Students who do not wear the school uniform will not be able to participate at any Out of School Activities including camps and excursions or represent the school officially at activities such as SAPSASA, etc.

## Unacceptable School Wear

- Anything not specified as acceptable uniform
- Pants, shorts, skirts or tops with logos other than the school logo
- Short revealing skirts or shorts (must be mid-thigh or longer)
- Make-up of any sort. Stick on transfers and tattoos are also not acceptable
- Jewellery or head bands-hair-ties not in school colours
  - *Exceptions are small inconspicuous earrings or medical alert bracelets*
