On Monday we welcomed all students back to face to face learning. It has been a relatively smooth transition and students are certainly very happy to be back at school.

Our school has been given 5 air purifiers to monitor air quality. We are rotating them between classes to determine where the greatest need is. The Department are continuing to ensure the

COVID safe measures are in place including all students and staff must stay home if unwell, even mildly. Face masks are currently still recommended for students in year 3-6 and all adults must wear a mask when on site. Teachers may remove their mask if it impedes their ability to teach.

Parents of reception students are still able to drop off and pick up their child. All other students in years 1 – 6 will continue to be dismissed from their classroom and parents can collect them from the school boundary or kiss and drop as required by The Department guidelines.
