Thank you for your support over the last few weeks as we navigate the impact of COVID on our school.

Pupil Free Day

Our Pupil Free day last Friday was very successful with exciting initiatives being implemented school-wide based on best practice. The day focussed predominantly on professional development around <u>DIBELS</u> and a data management system called <u>Amplify</u>. DIBELS (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills) is a set of procedures and measures for assessing the acquisition of literacy skills. They are designed to be short fluency measures that can be used to regularly detect risk and monitor the development of Literacy and reading skills in reception through to Year 6. All classroom teachers and SSOs have now been trained in how to implement DIBELS testing.

The second part of the day we split into Professional Learning Teams. The Reception to Year 3 teachers worked with Jackie on implementing <u>Decodable readers</u> and <u>Explicit Direct Instruction</u> to explicitly teach phonics and morphology, based on the <u>Science of</u> <u>Reading</u>. The year 4-6 teachers worked with Paul to consolidate knowledge about <u>Scaffolding Literacy</u>. Scaffolded Literacy explicitly teaches students how to read, comprehend and write complex texts and develop more sophisticated reading, writing and language skills.
