Room 4 Update – Year 1

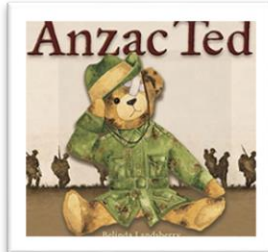
In Room 4 we read the story ANZAC TED by Belinda Landsberry.
