### **Scaffolded Literacy**

last of the school's 2022 support package, along with planning for Term 4 teaching. The strategies Paul and Stephanie have negotiated for 2023 are all planned with a view to continuing to develop teachers' ownership of professional learning and take-up of scaffolded pedagogy-which are the core goals of Steph's consultancy.

Just like this year, in 2023, the first two visits per term will be offered to plan for the upcoming term but the second 2 visits will be prioritised for intensive support strategies, negotiated with individuals. E.g. negotiated observation and feedback sessions, planning for these lessons, planning for specific literate content etc. Essentially, whatever literate focus teachers would like to explore. Unlike 2022, these 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> visits will not necessarily be on consecutive days as this doesn't always allow for differentiation.

Another strategic initiative being offered is the opportunity to get a head start on 2023 by meeting with Steph to make tentative age-appropriate genre, text type or even specific title selections for 2023. Each genre has text types that are required teaching for particular year levels so, once teachers know their 2023 year level/s, we can make a start on what students should be covering across 2023. These sessions will be negotiated with individuals and can occur on or offsite, any time after Term 4 has concluded-between 'Week 10' Term 4 and Week 0, 2023

Paul and Steph have negotiated to offer formal PD sessions in Week 0 concentrating on The Genres of Schooling - navigating the literacies of the Learning Areas
