We have already started the first of our Dibels assessments for 2023 and will be using our Amplify database to track and monitor students Literacy skills across all year levels.

DIBELS (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills) is a set of procedures and measures for assessing the acquisition of

literacy skills. They are designed to be short fluency measures that can be used to regularly detect risk and monitor the development of Literacy and reading skills in Reception through to Year 6. This data is used to make strategic decisions around our targeted explicit intervention programs and provide resources to support high quality teaching.
